You will experience the dogs quartering the fields closely to you and then going into a staunch point while you carefully get into position, giving you the time to place your well aimed shot after the bird flushes.

Hunt includes: meals, drinks, licenses, bird cleaning, cart rental and guides. Not included are 5.5% sales tax, pro shop items, snow goose permits, shot shells and gratuities. An optional snow goose hunt is available in place of a pheasant hunt.
